1. The team manager or one designated person from each team is **REQUIRED** to **PHONE** in the game scores.
2. Information needed for phoning in game scores can be found on the game card for each game. This information includes:
 - The toll free number used to phone in the score.
 - The event ID number.
 - The PIN number.
 - The game number.
