



## Rules and Procedures for Club Pass Players for the NISL Tournament

The following procedure will be used:

1. Teams choose which Club Pass player(s) (**up to 4**) they intend to use for the **DURATION** of the tournament.
2. The club pass player(s) will be on that roster for the **ENTIRE** tournament.
3. Teams **CANNOT** change club pass players **DURING** the tournament.
4. Players **MAY NOT play "down"** from ISL, MRL teams or within their own age group division during the NISL Tournament.
  - a. **Example:** A primary player on a U11 Girls Premier Division Team **cannot** move down and play during the tournament on a U11 Girls 1<sup>st</sup> Division Team.
5. Players can play on two (2) teams so long as they are not in the same age group division.
  - a. The **Original** player card must be with the **Primary** team cards.
  - b. A **black and white LAMINATED copy of BOTH SIDES** of the player card must be with the **Secondary** team cards.
6. It will be up to the coaches to manage the playing time of the player.

\*US Soccer Best Practices states that no players should play in more than two (2) games per day.

**\*\*\* NISL will not honor any special scheduling requests to facilitate player conflicts. There simply is no fair (or possible) way to make sure every CP player can get to every game.**

Necessary club pass paperwork for tournament:

1. Complete the **Club Pass Player Form**, listing all club pass players for your team on the same form (click here for the form).
2. Original copy of the player card is to be kept with each player's primary team.
3. The black and white laminated copy of both sides of the player card is to be kept with the secondary team cards.
